

Ordinance No. 2022-05

**ORDINANCE OF THE ALLAMUCHY TOWNSHIP MAYOR AND COUNCIL
CONCERNING POSITION OF TAX COLLECTOR**

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:9-141, *et seq.*, municipalities shall provide by ordinance for the appointment of a Tax Collector.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Allamuchy as follows:

Section I

The Allamuchy Township Code is amended by adding thereto a new Section 4-6.1, to read as follows:

§ 4-6.1. Tax Collector.

A. Appointment. The Township shall appoint a Tax Collector pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:9-141, *et seq.*, who shall be the official charged with the duty of collecting taxes within the Township.

B. Duties. The Tax Collector shall have, perform and discharge all the functions, powers and duties prescribed by law for a collector of taxes ~~including, without limitation:~~

1. The oversight of the bookkeeping, calculation, and accounting functions to comply with all state law and municipal directives in the collection of personal and property taxes including the proper calculation, preparation, and mailing of tax bills, the receipt and detailed accounting of all monies and/or checks received, the timely and accurate accounting and reporting of the activities of the office as required by state law and municipal directive, and assisting in the administration of procedures for the enforcement of timely payment of all due taxes.

2. ~~Distribution of public notices of the time and place of all~~ tax sales, including Water and Sewer taxes which include a description of property and total amount due at the time of the sale, the placing of notices in designated public places, and the publishing of same in an area newspaper pursuant to state statute.

3. Conduct of tax sales on all delinquent property and water/sewer accounts at least once each year.

Section II


1. Each clause, section or subsection of this ordinance shall be deemed a separate provision to the intent that if any such clause, section or subsection should be declared invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected.

2. All ordinances or parts of ordinance inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistency.


3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.


